Responsibilities

- Provide direct patient care under the supervision of the Medical Director focusing on health promotion, disease prevention, and treatment of acute and chronic illnesses, while practicing within the scope of practice as delineated by the practitioner's education and experience.
- Refer patients for specialty consultations or difficult problems
- Must be committed to the BHMC Mission, vision and goals, inclusive of participating in fundraising and community events.

Position Highlights & Benefits

- Optimal work schedule
 - Monday-Thursday 8:00 am-4:30 pm (clinic days)
 - Friday (administrative & urgent care visit day)
 - No weekends and no on-call required
- 8 paid holidays, available after 1st date worked
- 108 hours of Paid Time Off (PTO) after the first 90 days of employment
 - 144 hours/year after 1st anniversary
 - PTO increases in increments, based on years of service, up to 28 days/year
 - 40 hours total can be carried over
- Malpractice, health, dental, vision, short-term, long-term, and life insurance premiums paid **100%** by BHMC
 - Dependent/family coverage available for purchase through payroll deduction (health, dental, vision)
- Retirement through Northwestern Mutual, with an employer match up to 3%
 - Can be rolled over if position is vacated
- Continuing Education (CE) allowance and time off (up to 40 hours) for CE
 - CE allowance can also be used towards license fees, Up to Date online reference, and other reference materials

Qualifications

- Candidates must be able to treat patients of all ages
- Three years of clinical experience in family medicine preferred, but not required
- Must be board-certified or board eligible
