

Case Manager/Educator

Health Brigade is seeking a full-time case manager/educator. This position is responsible for providing HIV testing services to individuals who are incarcerated, HIV/HCV/STI education in incarcerating settings, and case management services to individuals living with HIV. The ideal candidate is well versed in current issues affecting incarcerated individuals and has an understanding of HIV/STIs. This role will be responsible for all educational activities in Department of Corrections facilities. The Department of Corrections requires a background check and drug test for substances illegal in Virginia as clearance to be able to provide services in their facilities. The ideal candidate will be able to gain entry into Department of Corrections.

Education and experience:

2 years of experience in HIV prevention/care, case management or other related health or human service experience. Bachelor's degree from an accredited college or university a plus. Individuals who have experienced incarceration are encouraged to apply.

Skills and Abilities

- Knowledge of HIV/HCV/STI prevention
- Ability to facilitate groups
- Trained as or willing to be trained as an HIV test counselor
- Ability to communicate effectively
- Demonstrate strong organizational skills
- Demonstrate an understanding of social justice issues
- Knowledge of community resources
- Ability to organize work, coordinate projects, set priorities, adhere to deadlines and follow-up on assignments with minimal direction
- Must have reliable personal transportation
- Willing and able to work with diverse staff and clients, including racial/ethnic minorities & the LGBTQ+ community
- Demonstrate attention to detail and ability to maintain accurate records and client documentation
- Candidates must demonstrate oral and written communication skills. Computer skills and proficiency in Microsoft Office products are required.

Employees must be able to work collaboratively with a variety of staff within the organization. Health Brigade expects individuals to have a strong work ethic and commitment to our mission and values. Must be able to work in a team environment as well as independently. The successful candidate must possess skills that support and enable sound decision making.
