To provide mental health and substance use services (individual and group counseling) to clients served at Health Brigade. These services are provided in a professional office setting and virtually.

- Master's degree in Social Work, Counseling, Psychology, or closely related field required.
- Licensed (or license-eligible) as a mental health professional in the State of Virginia. If not yet licensed in Virginia, obtain a license within 2 years of date of hire.
- Experience providing mental health and substance use counseling.
- Experience and knowledge of various therapeutic modalities including motivational interviewing and harm reduction.
- Must possess skills and knowledge of successful rapport building, treatment planning, evidenced-based counseling practices, diagnostic criteria, and biopsychosocial assessments.
- Knowledge of the impact of trauma on an individual's functioning.
- Skilled at managing time and personal/professional boundaries with clients.
- Cultural sensitivity and competence in serving a diverse population.
- Excellent oral and written skills, including detailed case documentation and ability to meet reporting deadlines.
- Bilingual in Spanish preferred.

Candidate will be expected to keep accurate and timely records of appointments (e.g., intake notes, progress notes, termination summaries) using HB's Electronic Medical Record; maintain confidentiality of records; and follow all grant requirement pursuant to assessment and data collection.
